VENTURA COUNTY WRITERS CLUB MOVING TO NEW MEETING SITE

Borders Books in Oxnard will be new location starting January 11, 2011

(Ventura, CA – December 1, 2010) After many years in Thousand Oaks, the Ventura County Writers Club has found a new home in the west part of the county – Borders Books in the Esplanade Shopping Center, just off the 101 Freeway. The change in location is due to the closing of the Borders store in Thousand Oaks. Meeting will continue at the Oxnard store beginning at 7 PM the second Tuesday of every month, except December. The meetings are free and open to the public.

“This was a very difficult decision as to where to move our meetings that would be best for the entire membership,” stated Lee Wade, VCWC president. “The strong writing community in Ventura County has been very supportive of our meetings with attendance averaging just over 75 people per meeting and sometimes maxing out at over 100 people this year. We will be changing the meeting format to give the main speaker a longer period of time to lecture and then take questions.”

A new short feature being added to the meetings will be “Hot Tips and Tricks” presented by club members and covering a variety of topics including tricky grammar questions, latest trends in promoting books, etc. A different club member will present this short segment each month and the topic will change monthly.
