Ventura County Writers Club Awards Winners of 2011 Poetry Contest
Over 300 entries were received with one winner from New York

(Ventura, CA – April 20, 2011) Over 100 people attended the awards ceremony Tuesday night, April 12 for the 2011 Ventura County Writers Club Poetry Contest, where many of the winners read their poems. Melissa Grossman, this year's chair for the contest, was the emcee for the evening, introducing each winner in all three categories. She also thanked the contest's judges: First readers Jackson Wheeler, Maggie Westland, and Joyce LaMers with the final judge being poet Kate Buckley.

First place winner for the Adult category, Virginia Anderson, commented on how wonderful it was to see so many young people submitting poems of such high quality.
